Volunteers will visit the home of the 7th president to assist in maintenance projects

HERMITAGE, Tenn. (June 4, 2019) – One hundred volunteers from Deloitte will descend upon Andrew Jackson's Hermitage to help with a variety of projects for the 20th annual Impact Day on Friday, June 7. This year marks the 15th consecutive year that Deloitte's Nashville practice has partnered with The Hermitage, one of the longest partnerships between the two entities.
