### **ANDREW JACKSON'S HERMITAGE REOPENS ON TUESDAYS**

**WHAT:** Andrew Jackson's Hermitage has added Tuesdays back to its days of operation. Starting Tuesday, July 5<sup>th</sup>, the presidential site will be open six days a week, giving tourists and locals an extra day in the week to see the National Historic Landmark.

Since June 2020, The Hermitage has been operating on limited hours and days of operation, due to the pandemic. The site will remain closed on Wednesdays for additional staff training, as well as ongoing maintenance and repair projects.

**WHEN:** Thursdays through Tuesdays, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

**ADDITIONAL:** Available ticket options include the *Mansion Tour*, *VIP Tour*, *In Their Footsteps: Lives of the Hermitage Enslaved Tour*, *Commander in Chief Tour*, *Arboretum Tour* and the *Grounds Pass*. All tickets include access to the audio tour, *Born for a Storm* exhibit, as well as the film, *Jackson*. Tickets start at \$19 for adults and \$12 for children.

All tickets for those 21 years of age and older include a discounted wine tasting at the Natchez Hills Winery at Andrew Jackson's Hermitage. Visitors can also purchase wine flights, wine by the glass or bottle and the popular wine slush.

Tickets sell quickly, so advance purchases are recommended.
